This position works with the Social and Emotional Wellbeing team to develop and implement prison support programs for male clients in correctional centres returning to the communities of Cape York. The role assists male youth and men with their reintegration back into community, by providing culturally appropriate support and advocacy.

- Demonstrated experience in AOD program and group facilitation with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Understanding of the historical and contemporary issues that impact on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and their communities, particularly in Cape York, and
- Ability to communicate sensitively and effectively with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in accordance with community protocols and customs
