- Walks without help
- Tries to climb stairs
- Can stack 3 cubes

Social and emotional wellbeing:

- Says simple words
- Copies other people
- Points to objects or pictures when named

Immunisations due:

- Measles, mumps, rubella, varicella (chickenpox)
- Haemophilus influenzae type B (Hib)
- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough)
- Hepatitis A

4 YEARS

Physical skills:

• Hops and stands on one foot for a few seconds


 Uses scissors to cut simple shapes

Social and emotional wellbeing:

- Speaks in full sentences and tells stories
- Enjoys playing pretend and asking lots of questions
- Understands taking turns in play

Immunisations due:

- Diphtheria, tetanus, polio pertussis (whooping cough),
- Pneumococcal
- Hepatitis A


If bub is still learning some skills or you're worried about how they're growing, it's okay to ask for help.

Do you want to know how your bub is growing?

Keep track of your bub's growth and their immunisation with this handy guide.

It shows the ages of your bub and how bub should be developing and growing at that age. Bub grows really quickly! Make sure your bub's growth is on track and that bub can get their immunisation at each stage of their growth.

Keeping healthy means getting bub's immunisations on time. Being on time will protect them from disease so that they grow up strong.

BIRTH

Physical skills:

• Starts moving head from side to side

Social and emotional wellbeing:

Cries when hungry, uncomfortable or wants to be held

Immunisations due:

- Hepatitis B (given in hospital)
- Tuberculosis
- Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) (unless mum's had it when pregnant)



4 MONTHS

Physical skills:

- Hold head up without support
- May push up on hands during tummy time

Social and emotional wellbeing:

- Shows interest in watching faces and objects
- Begins to babble and make different sound

Immunisations due:

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), polio, hepatitis B, Haemophilus influenzae type B (Hib)
- Pneumococcal
- Rotavirus
- Meningococcal B



9 MONTHS

Physical skills:

- Gets to a sitting position by themselves
- Sits without support
- Crawls
- Looks for objects when dropped out of sight (like a spoon or toy)
- Bangs two things together

Social and emotional wellbeing:

- Shows facial expressions like: happy, sad, angry, and surprised
- Makes a lot of different sounds like 'mamamama' and 'bababababa'











2 MONTHS

Physical skills:

- Begins to lift head during tummy time
- Opens and closes hands

Social and emotional wellbeing:

- Starts to smile socially
- Begins to follow things with eyes

Immunisations due (can get from 6 weeks old):

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), hepatitis B, Haemophilus influenzae type B (Hib), polio
- Pneumococcal
- Rotavirus
- Meningococcal B



6 MONTHS

Physical skills:

- Rolls from tummy to back, pushes up with straight arms when on tummy
- Reaches to grab a toy they want

Social and emotional wellbeing:

• Takes turns making sounds with you, and makes squealing noises

Immunisations due:

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), hepatitis B, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type B (Hib)
- Pneumococcal



12 MONTHS

Physical skills:

- Pulls self up to stand.
- Walks while holding on to furniture
- Picks up small objects with thumb and finger

Social and emotional wellbeing:

- Can say 2-3 words such as mama, dada or nanna
- May be shy or anxious with strangers

Immunisations due:

- Measles, mumps, rubella
- Meningococcal ACWY
- Pneumococcal
- Meningococcal B
